Training Course Details

ABSTRACT

Content Management Systems (CMS) over the past few years have transformed the way websites are developed and managed. This course covers the two most commonly used ones (Joomla & Typo3); the training will be conducted by e-Business Developers. eBD is an ICT company focusing on offering e-Business solutions to clients and the solutions we provide include mainly system, application & website development. At eBD, the members of the core team of IT professionals have been working in this field for over nine years covering various developments, setups & system management.

COURSE OVERVIEW

1. This CMS Training is designed for Individuals who want to learn how to manage and develop Joomla/Typo3 websites. We are considering that some participants may have busy work schedules, thus the group training will be only on Saturdays & Sundays as per the calendar on the sign up page. Individual training may be scheduled for selected days during the week.
2. The introduction level is only theoretical, mainly for management purposes only and a laptop may not be required for the training. For the practical training, (intermediate/advanced levels) all trainees will be required to have a laptop to facilitate in training practice. By the end of the training, the trainees will be expected to have a fully functional website that can be uploaded online.
3. Each trainee (intermediate/advanced level) will be given .co.rw domain name of choice & hosting space to upload their website & make it available online for a period of one year at no extra cost. After the first year, additional charges will apply depending on the chosen hosting plan.
4. After the introduction level, those requiring more advanced knowledge can sign up for the intermediate and advanced levels, which will cover more detailed concepts of the CMS Backend and how to actually create a website from scratch as well as template customization.
